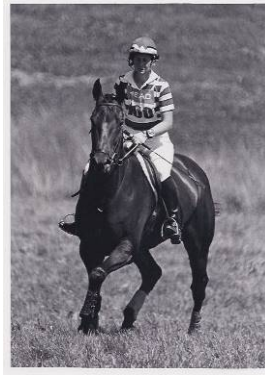
THE RED SHUTTERS FARM TROPHY



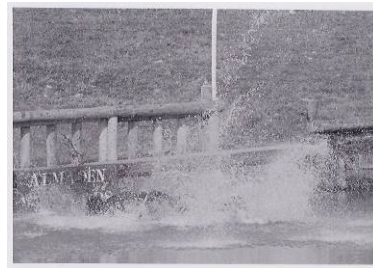
Originally awarded to MCTA's leading Training level rider of any age, this trophy was designated specifically for Junior/Young Riders in 1981 and limited to juniors in 2025. Points may come from any Training level event, recognized or unrecognized. Beginning in 2019 they may also be earned at the Modified level of unrecognized events only. The trophy was donated by Shockey and Iva Gillet and named for the farm on Evna Road in Parkton where they lived when they first became active in MCTA—and while their daughter Iva was becoming one of the country's top Young Riders.

Raised at Red Shuttters Farm, Iva Gillet progressed from D Pony Club rallies with Green Spring all the way to jumping clean at the Advanced level of the Chesterland 3-Day—the predecessor of today's Fair Hill 5*—while her dad organized the MCTA Horse Trials during most of the 1980s and her mom was always working behind the scenes at a hundred different jobs. Along the way she won MCTA's Schaurek Rider of the Year Trophy as a junior in 1979 and 1980 and then the Laubach Trophy as a senior in 1983.



Iva's New Zealand-bred Thoroughbred The Catalyst was known for bouncing one-strides and other athletic feats, and he was named MCTA's Horse of the Year in both 1982 and '83. But we all make mistakes sometimes, as these shots of Iva taking a bath in a Preliminary division at Chesterland clearly show! [Fortunately there were no injuries.]
